Climate changes

- Before the visit, the students collect facts about their own country's fight for climate change.
 - 1) Which are the energy sources of my country?
 - 2) What is the energy used for (transports, industries etc.)? Try to find specific numbers, like 50% is used for industries.
 - 3) What are my country's climate emissions? (This year or as late as you have figures.)
 - 4) What were my country's climate emissions 1990?
 - 5) What are my country's climate goals?

They shall also check out the climate goals of EU (can be found in a document at the platform).

- The students visit the exhibition "Mission: Climate earth" and get the basics facts of climate changes (in groups).
- Afterwards, the students sit down in their groups and present the facts for their countries.
- At last, the students get to discuss what **they** can do to reduce climate emissions. They fill out a form with their suggestions and every student gets a copy of the form.
