

OVERVIEW

Ecole Alsacienne is a unique institution in France. Founded 150 years ago, we are a private school located in central Paris. In Upper School, our pupils participate in at least two internships, and we offer a wide array of electives, foreign language exchanges and extracurricular activities (theatre, music, cinema, debate, school governance...).

THE FRENCH BACCALAUREATE STRUCTURE

The French Baccalaureate emphasizes continuous assessment throughout the last two years of high school, in addition to written and oral examinations. All students take a set of compulsory courses and choose three advanced-level concentrations, two of which are continued through senior year and serve as a platform for the Grand Oral final exam.

Core modules:

French Literature (junior year), Philosophy (senior year), History & Geography, General Science, 2 foreign languages, Civics, Physical Education.

Advanced-level concentrations:

Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry, Life & Earth Sciences, Computer Science, Economics & Social Sciences, History Geography & Global Politics, Humanities Literature & Philosophy, English Literature.

RESULTS & RANKING

Our students consistently achieve high marks on the French Baccalaureate (Highest Honors: 39.3%, High Honors: 37.6%, Honors: 16.1% in 2025).

Curriculum diversity precludes meaningful rankings. We do not weigh grades or calculate a cumulative GPA.

Predicted grades are based on continuous assessment and average marks in 11th grade. We remain objective and aim at making predicted grades achievable.

GRADING SCALE

French students receive grades out of 20. We convert as follows:

CURRICULUM

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

Many languages are taught at our school: English, German, Italian, Mandarin, Spanish, Russian, Latin and Ancient Greek. Students must take two; many choose three. We also offer **European and Oriental Sections** where students may study science in English, and history-geography in Chinese, German or English. Additionally, we offer a **bilingual English course**, geared toward native speakers, and focused on literature, writing, and civilization. On average 200 students participate in foreign exchange programs each year.

COMMUNITY SERVICE & INTERNSHIPS

Students complete at least two internships before graduating, one of which often consists of a 3-week community service project with a partner charity for a minimum of 100 volunteer hours. Many students also initiate their own service projects and fundraising under the school's supervision.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students can participate in a variety of clubs (science, debate, sports...). Our drama club and chamber music orchestra both perform at a semi-professional level. Some of our pupils have chosen Ecole Alsacienne for its "classe musicale" which offers an adjusted schedule and enables middle schoolers to attend academic classes in the morning and the local conservatory in the afternoon.

UNIVERSITY PLACEMENT OUTSIDE FRANCE (2021-2025)

All of our students are bound for higher education. The majority stay in France where they attend the renowned Grandes Ecoles and top research universities. **In 2025, 23% of the graduating class began their university studies abroad.**
